Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.

The following notice gives notice of the variation and consolidation of an environmental permit.

Powerday PLC have applied to vary the current Environmental Permit (waste management licence EAWML 80328) for the Enfield Waste Management Facility. The facility currently accepts a range of solid-non-hazardous waste for transfer purposes only. The variation extends the facility permitted area, increases the range of permitted waste management activities, allows an external wood shredding operation and waste storage, and modernises the current permit to modern EPR conditions. Main changes to the permit relate to permitted activities, including the recovery of wastes in a new enclosed materials recovery facility (MRF) the addition of two Schedule 1 activities for the purposes of refuse derived fuel production. Existing waste transfer activities are retained and may still occur as and when necessary. There are no point source emissions to land, air or water. The variation does not increase the permitted annual throughput tonnage or change the types of waste accepted.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit.
